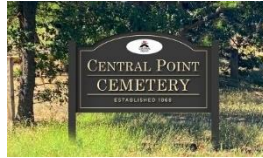

Therefore, the Central Point City Cemetery Improvement Committee (C.P.C.C.I.C.) was formed to insure that monies will be available for the maintenance and care of our loved ones beyond the very small amount of funding provided by the tax payers in the City's annual budget. Your donations are so very important to restore our Cemetery to the place of peace and tranquility it deserves.

Our loved ones resting in our lovely little pioneer cemetery don't know of our busy lives, of course. We don't often have time to maintain the plots like folks used to back in the day. We can now entrust that care to the C.P.C.C.I.C. along with the City for today and beyond. But, we need your help. Improvements have already begun. There are over 260 trees in the cemetery that need immediate attention, 13 of which need to be removed immediately because they are accidents waiting to happen. The Committee has already provided funding for this project. We are also planning to revamp the pathways which are overgrown, and we are in the process of bringing much needed water to the Cemetery through our coordination with the City of Central Point.
